TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

CITY TOUR

Thursday, September 7

We'll begin the morning at the Chinese Gardens, an authentically built Ming Dynasty style garden. Covered walkways, bridges, open colonnades, pavilions and a richly planted landscape frame Zither Lake, creating views that are never twice the same. Not-to-miss sites during a driving tour of Portland include the Forecourt Fountain opposite the Civic Auditorium, Salmon Street Springs in Waterfront Park, and Pioneer Courthouse Square, Portland's outdoor living room. In Washington Park, walk through the world-renowned International Rose Test Gardens. The gardens boast 10,000 varieties of roses planted on three terraces. Queen's Walk, at the end of the gardens, offers what locals consider the most spectacular view of the city. We'll also drive by Powell's Book Store and the Portland Art Museum, as you may want to return there later in the week on your own.

PEARSON AIR FIELD

Thursday, September 7

Spend the morning at Pearson Air Field, in nearby Vancouver, Washington. The Air Field is the oldest, active airfield in the country. The Pearson Air Museum is also home to the country's oldest wooden hangar. Built in 1918 as part of the US Army Spruce Division, it has been used as an airplane hangar since 1921. It even housed Italian prisoners of war during WWII. The museum is currently home to over ten aircraft dating back to 1912.

EVERGREEN AVIATION MUSEUM

Friday, September 8

Board bus for a scenic drive through the rolling hills of Oregon wine country to McMinnville for a visit to the Evergreen Aviation Museum. Join the dream to fly and explore the fascinating world of aviation history. You will have up-close and personal encounters with an extensive vintage aircraft collection including Howard Hughes' massive Flying Boat, "Spruce Goose." You will be inspired by their collection of aircraft and aviation artifacts while experiencing the thrill of aviation through exciting exhibits, demonstrations, events and educational activities. Enjoy a boxed lunch at the Museum consisting of a turkey sandwich, potato salad, cookie and beverage.
